
FIELD SERVICE (MECHANICAL)

Rapid breakdown response, in-field diagnostics and mechanical repairs to restore equipment safely and efficiently with minimal downtime.



AUTO ELECTRICAL

Advanced fault finding, wiring repairs, system diagnostics and electrical component replacement for heavy mobile plant and support equipment. We also service and repair air conditioning systems and are ARctick certified.



MACHINERY OVERHAUL

Rebuilds, major repairs and component refurbishments to return equipment to reliable operating condition.



COMPONENT CHANGE-OUTS

Safe removal, installation and commissioning support for engines, transmissions, hydraulic components and other critical systems.

OUR EQUIPMENT

Westoz Equipment Repairs supports a wide range of heavy mobile plant, underground machinery and transport assets across Western Australia. Our team delivers practical, field-based maintenance and repair solutions designed to keep equipment safe, compliant and operating reliably – particularly in remote environments where workshop access may be limited.



SURFACE EQUIPMENT

We provide maintenance and breakdown support for surface mining and civil fleets, working directly in-field to minimise downtime.

Typical work scope:

- Breakdown diagnostics and in-field repair
- Hydraulic and mechanical repairs
- Component removal, installation and commissioning support
- Servicing, inspections and condition-based interventions

Equipment includes:

- Excavators, loaders and graders
- Dump trucks and ancillary support equipment
- General surface fleet and production plant

CASE STUDIES



RED DUST HOLDINGS CAT 150 GRADER, KALGOORLIE

A CAT 150 grader experienced a complex hydraulic fault on site in Kalgoorlie. Two contractors had already attended without resolving the issue, resulting in a week of downtime and escalating costs. The client was preparing to wait for OEM support, which would have added further delays. Westoz mobilised quickly, diagnosed the fault and had the machine back up and running the same day – avoiding extended downtime and getting production back on track.



CHARLES HULL CONTRACTING CAT 345DL EXCAVATOR, WAROONA

A CAT 345DL excavator was experiencing hydraulic overheating and poor performance, affecting reliability on site in Waroona. Multiple mechanics had attempted to diagnose the issue over 6-12 months without success. Westoz attended site and identified a faulty hydraulic pump with an incorrectly installed compensating valve, completing repairs and a full hydraulic system tune-up. The repair allowed the client to retain the machine in their fleet and keep their crushing operation running smoothly.



MCLEAN CONTRACTING HITACHI EXCAVATOR (GPS FINAL TRIM)

A Hitachi excavator used for high-precision GPS final trim work required structural repair to maintain accuracy and performance. Westoz carried out precision re-welding and rectification works to restore alignment and ensure the machine continued operating smoothly and accurately in demanding conditions.



STRAIGHTLINE RAIL & CIVIL FLEET MAINTENANCE SUPPORT, FORRESTFIELD

Straightline Civil & Rail required onsite afterhours servicing and preventative maintenance for a fleet of on-highway trucks and small civil earthmoving equipment during a busy project in Forrestfield. The machines needed to remain fully operational during working hours, leaving limited opportunity for maintenance during the day. Westoz implemented a tailored after-hours onsite maintenance program to ensure 100% machine availability with no disruption to project delivery.
